

DECLARATION OF RESULT**Academic Board Student Members Election**

On 14 September 2018 the Academic Board authorised a call for nominations for student members of the Academic Board for a term of two years, commencing 1 January 2019. The nomination and election process was conducted in accordance with the University's Election and Nomination Policy.

The call for nominations was sent to students on Monday 8 October 2018 and nominations closed at 5pm on Monday 22 October 2018.

Two nominations were received for each category. An election was held for each category, with the election portal open for votes from Wednesday 24 October to 5pm on Friday 29 October 2018.

Higher degree by research student member

Nominees:

1. Leonie Bird, Yarra Theological Union
2. Paul Daniels, Trinity College

20 votes were cast and no votes were excluded. Leonie Bird was elected with 55% of the vote.

Coursework student member

Nominees

1. Adrian Jackson, Whitley College
2. Shady Nessim, St Athanasius College

264 votes were cast and 35 votes were excluded as invalid. Shady Nessim was elected with 72% of the vote.

The results are declared as follows:

1. Leonie Bird was elected as research student member of the Academic Board for a term of two years from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2020.
2. Shady Nessim was elected as coursework student member of the Academic Board for a term of two years from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2020.
