Graduate Certificate in Professional Supervision

2023-2024

This award is comprised of three units. The same three units may be credited to the more advanced Graduate Diploma of Professional Supervision.

Beginning in October 2024, we are offering all three units of the Graduate Certificate in Professional Supervision over one summer.

Structure of Intensives

Each teaching session is 8 hours (9:00am-5:00pm), including one hour for lunch and other breaks.

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In addition to time spent reading and completing assessment tasks outside of class, student practitioners will also complete 8 hours of content engagement for each unit in their assigned peer groups, distributed before, between and after each teaching session.

Each unit will officially start three weeks before the first teaching session, and end roughly 4 weeks after the final teaching session, to allow time for required work conducted outside of class.

Student Practitioners may attend the mixed-mode, weekly intensive units **online** or **in-person** (Box Hill campus, Melbourne). However, they must select and continue one mode of attendance per unit.
