Graduate Certificate in Professional Supervision

2023

This award is comprised of three units. The same three units may be credited to the more advanced Graduate Diploma of Professional Supervision.

In 2023, we are offering two different intensive options and three entry points. The first option is constructed around 4 teaching sessions on Saturdays, entirely online (for each unit). The second option is constructed around 4 teaching sessions in a single week (for each unit). Additional work will be completed outside of class.

Each teaching session is 8 hours (9am-5:00pm), including one hour for lunch and other breaks.

In addition to time spent reading and completing assessment tasks outside of class, student practitioners will also complete 8 hours of content engagement for each unit in their assigned peer groups, distributed before, between and after each teaching session.

Each unit will officially start three weeks before the first teaching session, and end roughly 4 weeks after the final teaching session, to allow time for required work conducted outside of class.

Student Practitioners may attend the mixed-mode, weekly intensive units **online** or **in-person** (Box Hill campus, Melbourne). However, they must select and continue one mode of attendance per unit.
